

Version 2 HHCRO (Home Heating Cost Reduction Obligation)

- Own your home or rent from a private landlord, and also qualify or live with someone who qualifies in either section A, B or C below, **or**
- Private domestic premises listed in a Local Authority Declaration, **or**
- Rent your property from a Social Landlord with an Energy Performance Certificate (EPC) rating of E, F or G and at no point was a central heating system or electric storage heater present in the premises.

(You need to qualify in either A, B OR C below).

A. Receive one of the following:

- Pension Credit **Guarantee Credit** Element
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- Income-related employment and support allowance (ESA)
- Income Support

OR

B. Receive Tax Credits:

On the condition that the household's relevant income does not exceed the amount set out in the table below
